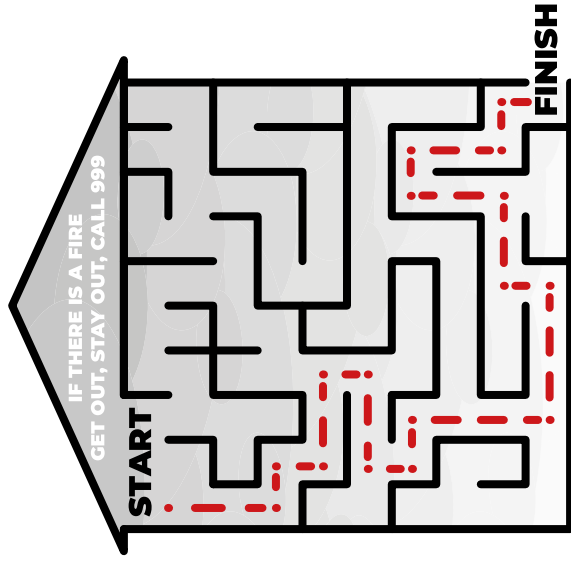

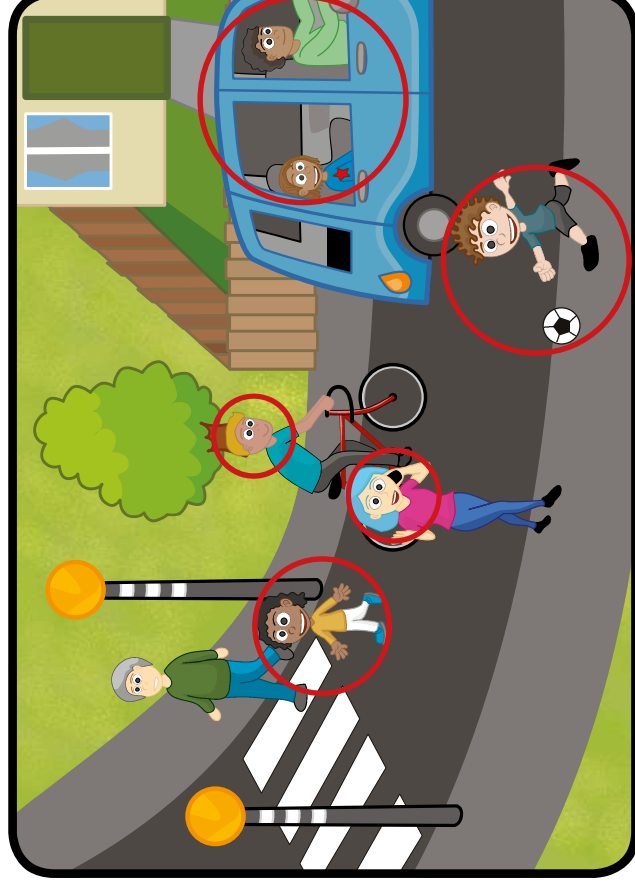

There are 5 differences.

- Crossing together vs child away from adult, it is safer to cross together, holding the grown-up's hand and using the crossing.
- Lady is using her mobile and is distracted. The lady not on the phone is paying attention and is aware of her surroundings.
- Carrying ball vs kicking ball. It is safer to carry the ball near a road as playing with a ball near a road could result in the ball going onto the road and into the path of a car.
- Wearing seatbelt vs not wearing seatbelt. Seatbelts help to keep passengers safely in their seat. This is especially important in case the car has a crash or has to stop all of a sudden. If you're under 135cm tall, you also need to use a car seat.
- Wearing helmet vs not wearing helmet. Helmets protect our heads in case we fall off or have an accident.
