I would like to request information under the Freedom of information act.

Please can you answer the following questions.

1. Do you have AEDs (defibrillators) in your service? – yes

2. If yes, where are your AEDs stored? (e.g. in Fire vehicles, inside the stations or outside of the station in a cabinet) – **fire service vehicles**

- 3. How many AEDs do you have? 50 in the service
- 4. What make & model are the AEDs please? **Phillips Heartstart FRx**

5. How old are the AEDs or what year were they purchased? – we have a vast inventory of AED's the average age at present is 7 years old

6. When would you look to replace your AEDs? – we have a rolling equipment replacement program to which based on age, will total the number of units required for any given financial year.

7. Who in your organisation deals with the maintenance of equipment such as AEDs? – **fire fighters carry out a schedule of checks as part of station routines**

8. Who is in charge of purchasing equipment such as AEDs? - engineering services are responsible for the purchasing of equipment

9. Where do you purchase AEDs from? SP services (UK) Ltd
